





# Grades PreK – 7

## June 24th to August 9th



### Space Explorers

Come blast off into summer 2019 at WNS Summer Camp: Space Explorers! Campers, ages 4 and up, will have the opportunity to learn about different components of space through a variety of project based learning and enrichment classes taught by our very own WNS teachers. Campers will have ample time to play outside, either at a local playground or on our outdoor terrace. Campers will also participate in hands-on fun enrichment activities, such as Cooking, Hip Hop, Mad Science, Robotics.

Want to explore the outer space in Spanish or Chinese? The Immersion week will be a perfect finale for campers to bring their newly acquired knowledge to a higher level!

#### Session 1: Planets June 24th - July 3rd

Our first camp session will serve as an introduction to the solar system. Campers will learn about each of the nine planets through a variety of hands-on fun projects and activities.

## **Session 2: Stars**

**July 8th - July 12th**

Through explorations of light and shadow, campers will learn about the composition of our night sky. Campers will use an artistic lens to investigate the function of stars, and the tools necessary to view them.

## **Session 3: Moon**

**July 15th - July 19th**

During this session campers will make most of their imagination as they explore the idea of space travel and see if it is actually made out of cheese. Deepening their explorations of light and shadow from Session 2, in Session 3 campers will dig deeper into the darkness of our nights on earth and the light the moon provides for us. This session will include an introduction in the phases of the moon and its path around the earth.

## **Session 4: Space Travel**

**July 22nd - July 26th**

During this session campers will investigate rocket ships and other space exploration vehicles, and begin to dig deeper into what it means to be an astronaut? What do they do? How do they do it? the people who have gone into space, what they have found, and the vehicles that took them there.

## **Session 5: Sun**

**July 29th - August 2nd**

Campers enrolled in Space Explorers Session 5 will take a deep dive into the sun! Campers will learn all about what lights our world and what exactly the sun is through a variety of fun hands-on projects and activities.

## **Immersion Camp: Space Odyssey**

**August 5th - August 9th (Chinese or Spanish Immersion)**

Blast into the week as we explore all things space, a perfect finale to extend from the previous five sessions. Background knowledge of the space will make the immersion week a lot more tangible and understandable for levels of all learners. Language immersion works best when campers are engaged by interesting, real world content. Each day, in either Spanish or Chinese, activities and projects are carefully designed to maximize campers' language input and output.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Can I leave my stroller at school when I drop off my child?

Unfortunately, we do not have a space to store strollers during the school day. We do have scooter racks that children can park their scooters or bikes for the day.

## Will my child's lunch be stored in a refrigerator?


We do not refrigerate campers' lunch. Lunch boxes will be stored in backpacks or cubbies and we recommend that campers keep ice packs inside their lunch boxes. We also cannot microwave lunches, please pack accordingly.

## Where do I drop-off/pickup my child?

Prekindergarten and Kindergarten students are dropped off and picked up at their classrooms. Campers who are entering 1st grade and older will be dropped off in the lobby and picked up at the Meeker Street entrance. If your child is enrolled in after camp, they will be picked up in the lobby.

## What is the walking procedure around the neighborhood?

Each class will leave the building without a minimum of two teachers. We take routes with the least foot traffic and are very conscientious of traffic patterns and busy intersections. Teachers will travel with emergency contact list and first aid kit at all times.
